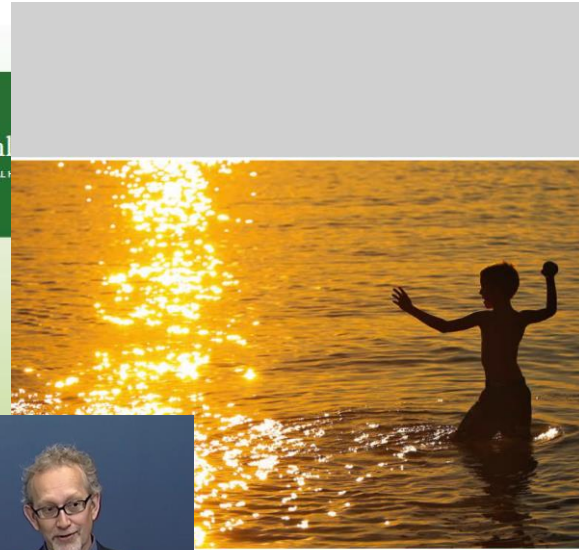

### About the Social Sustainability Forum

The Social Sustainability Forum is a Swedish forum for promoting welfare in a socially sustainable way. Through exchanging knowledge and experience, the Forum aims to help reduce health inequalities and provide for people's basic needs and rights. The Forum's activities are open to elected representatives, public servants and researchers in municipalities, county councils, the State, the business sector and non-governmental organisations. The Public Health Agency of Sweden and the Swedish Association of Local Authorities and Regions (SALAR) are jointly responsible and offer an annual conference, seminars and a website on current topics.
