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The EU4Health Programme is the response to the COVID-19 pandemic and aims to build a strong European Health Union by supporting legislative and non-legislative Union health priorities. The EU4Health Programme was adopted in March 2021 with a budget of EUR 5.3 billion over the period 2021-27. This represents an unprecedented level of financial commitment for the Union in health.

This targeted consultation is intended to seek the opinion of stakeholders about current and future Union health priorities and strategic orientations and on key health needs to be addressed through the EU4Health annual work programmes, providing inputs for reflection on the 2024 EU4Health work programme and beyond. Systematically over the years - despite the lessons learned from the pandemic, the biggest support is being given to biomedical approaches to health and healthcare, in terms of treatment and disease management. Prevention and health promotion via primary, integrated and community-based care have not been yet sufficiently addressed. Improved NCD prevention could reduce the burden by as much as 70%. Crisis preparedness and response plans have still not fully considered the relationship between the underlying systemic determinants of health and inequalities, behavioural and cultural insights, and societal resilience to poly-crises, this including the ongoing climate emergency.

1. systems-oriented reforms for and investments in health and integrated care systems via a health equity-conscious European Semester process and related tools;
2. health-enabling living environments and environmental health inequalities across lifecourse and social gradients (especially early years) as part of NCDs prevention strategic orientation; the traditional approaches are still mainly focused on the provision of lifestyle-oriented information to encourage people to modify their health and risk behaviours at the individual level, disregarding many deeper underlying socio-economic, commercial and environmental factors beyond individual control that affect their health choices;

5. clarify and reinforce the EU legal potential to leverage fiscal, pricing and income policies to improve key socio-economic determinants of health;
6. consider digital inclusion aspects of health literacy, while strengthening people's socioeconomic resilience & systems around;
7. ensure a wide spectrum of underlying determinants of the NCDs are addressed in a balanced way - tobacco, alcohol, diets, physical activity, environment, but also psycho-social aspects of living and working arrangements; move on making progress in the fight against NCDs by better focusing on the commercial drivers of ill-health as well as health inequalities such as the price, promotion, product and placing;
8. support to strengthen health promotion and disease prevention in community-based care systems and explore measures such as social prescribing and citizens engagement;

3. put prevention approaches upfront in activities supporting the digital transformation of healthcare, public health and broader care systems and health-promoting environments;
4. consider the expansion of the use of digital databases and tools, and data-gathering technologies and artificial intelligence in the field of the NCDs and their population-wide risk factors for smart data-informed preventive measures;
5. digital public health tools should not replace population-wide prevention measures, but form an integrated part of a comprehensive approach;
6. consider support toward creating EU (research) Mission on Health Promotion and Disease Prevention, and Health Inequalities & EU (research) Mission on Mental Health in All Policies.
