



Marmot Principles


- 1. Give every child the best start in life
- 2. Enable all children, young people and adults to maximise their capabilities and have control over their lives
- 3. Create fair employment and good work for all
- 4. Ensure healthy standard of living for all

- 5. Create and develop healthy and sustainable places and communities
- 6. Strengthen the role and impact of ill health prevention
- 7. Tackle racism, discrimination and their outcomes
- 8. Pursue environmental sustainability and health equity together








Changes in poor self-reported health in the high and low-education groups, 25–75-year-olds, 2014-2024



Do you think children today will have a better, worse of roughly the same life to you?








