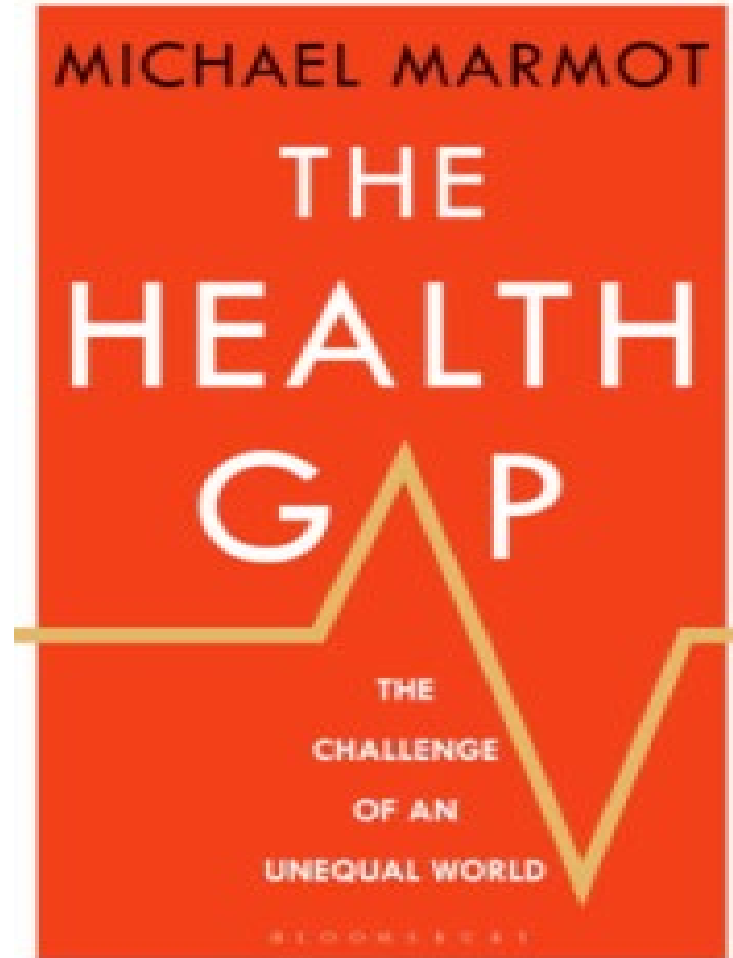

Marmot Principles

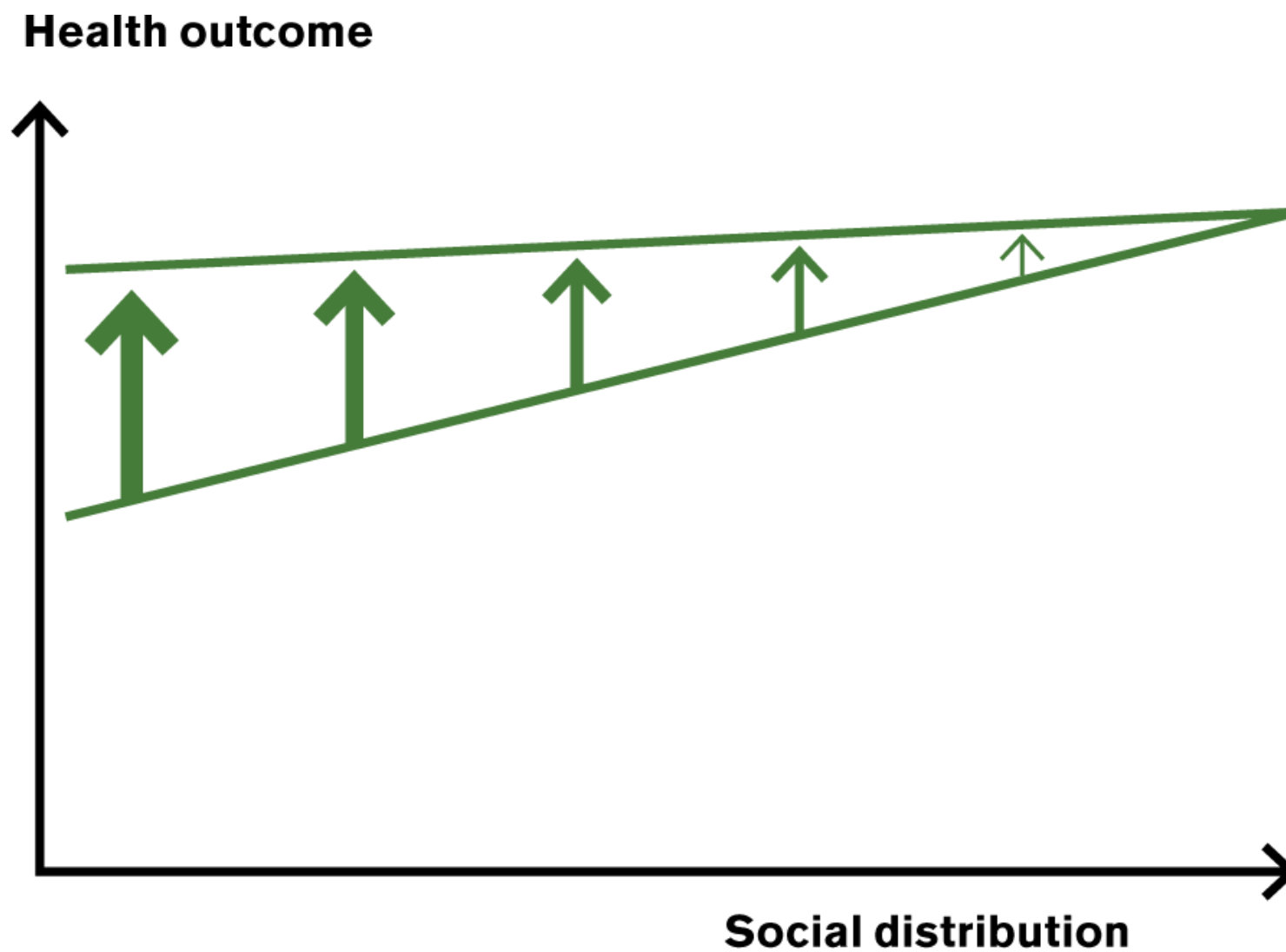


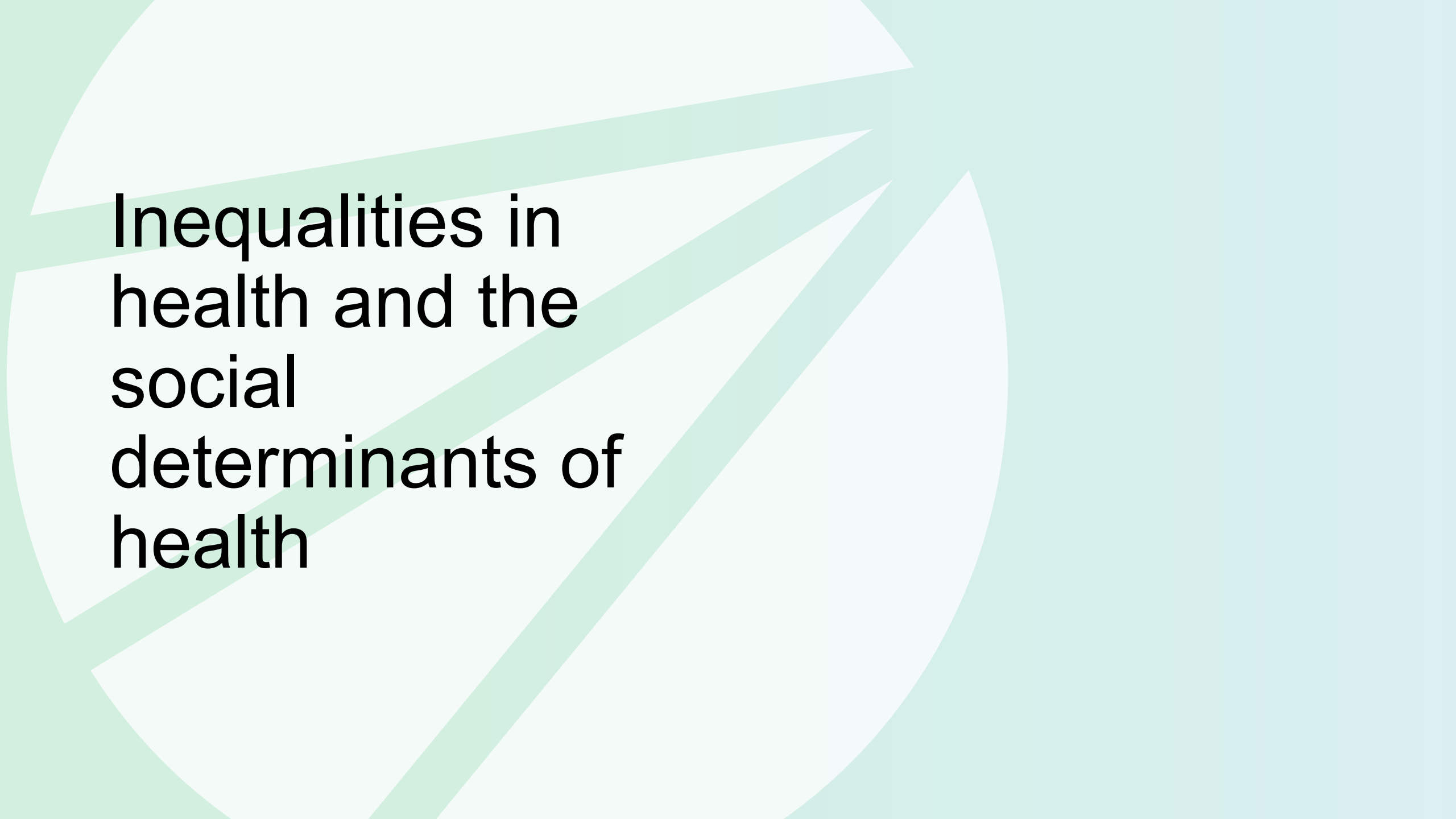
1. Give every child the best start in life
2. Enable all children, young people and adults to maximise their capabilities and have control over their lives
3. Create fair employment and good work for all
4. Ensure healthy standard of living for all
5. Create and develop healthy and sustainable places and communities
6. Strengthen the role and impact of ill health prevention
7. Tackle racism, discrimination and their outcomes
8. Pursue environmental sustainability and health equity together

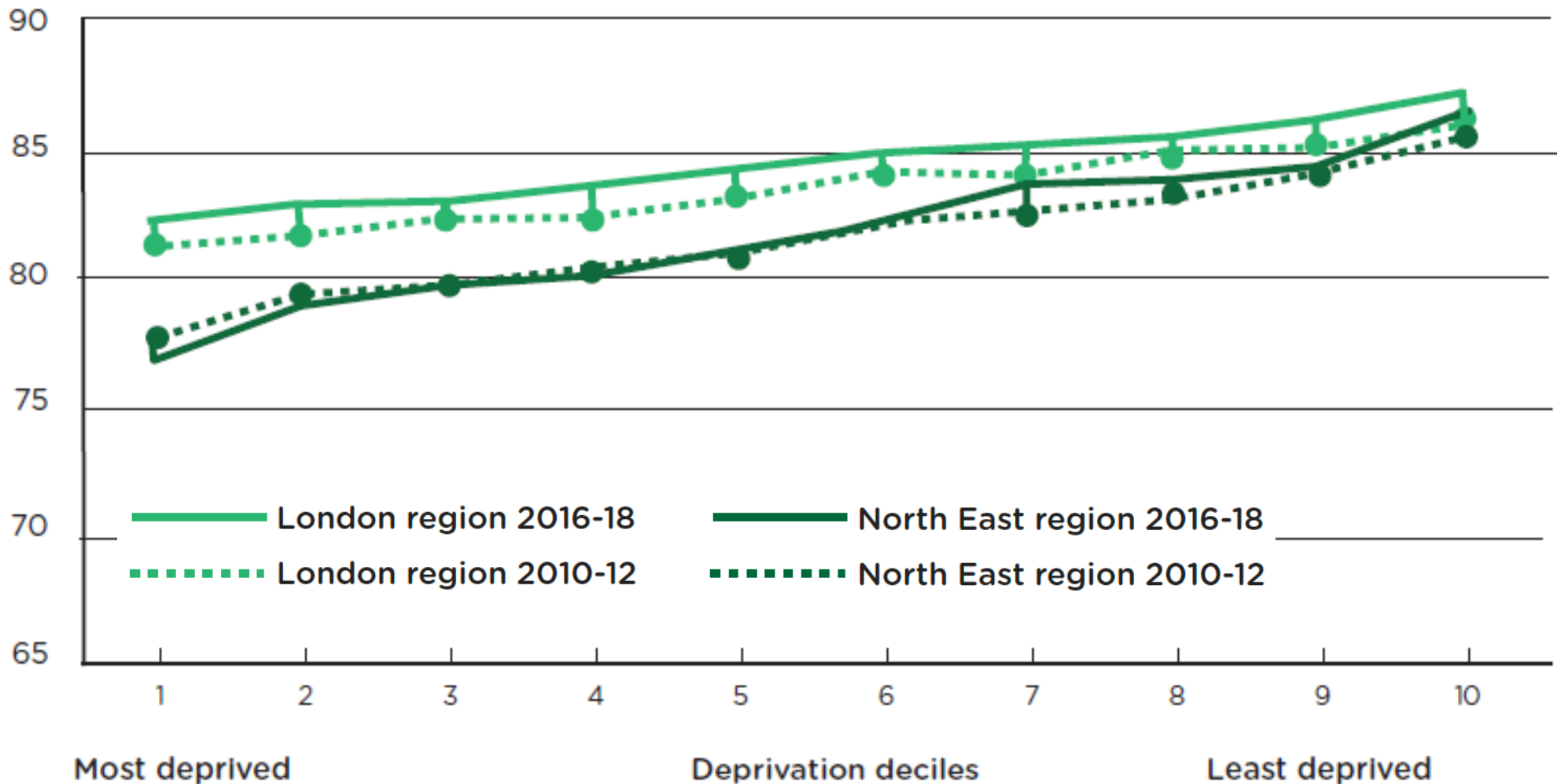

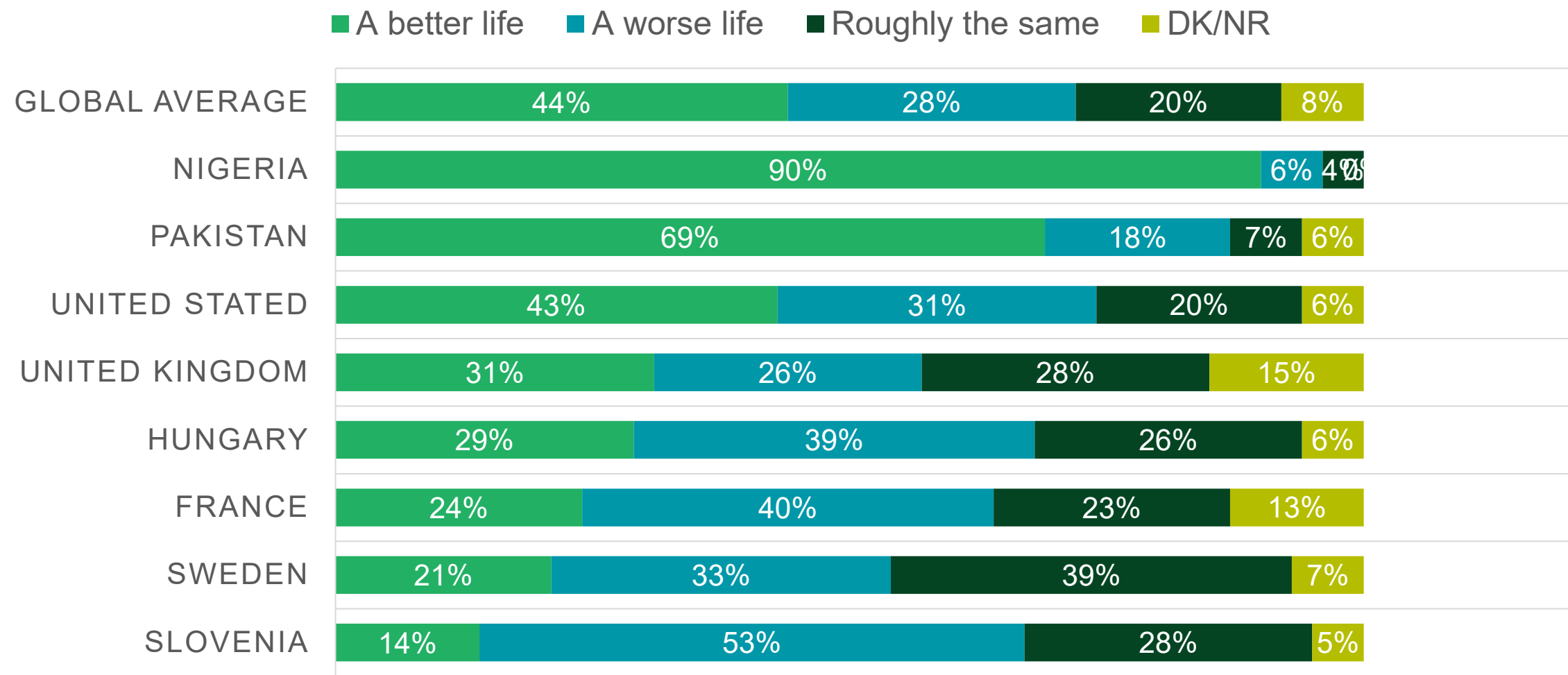
Life expectancy at birth by sex and deprivation deciles in London and the North East regions

Changes in poor self-reported health in the high and low-education groups, 25–75-year-olds, 2014-2024

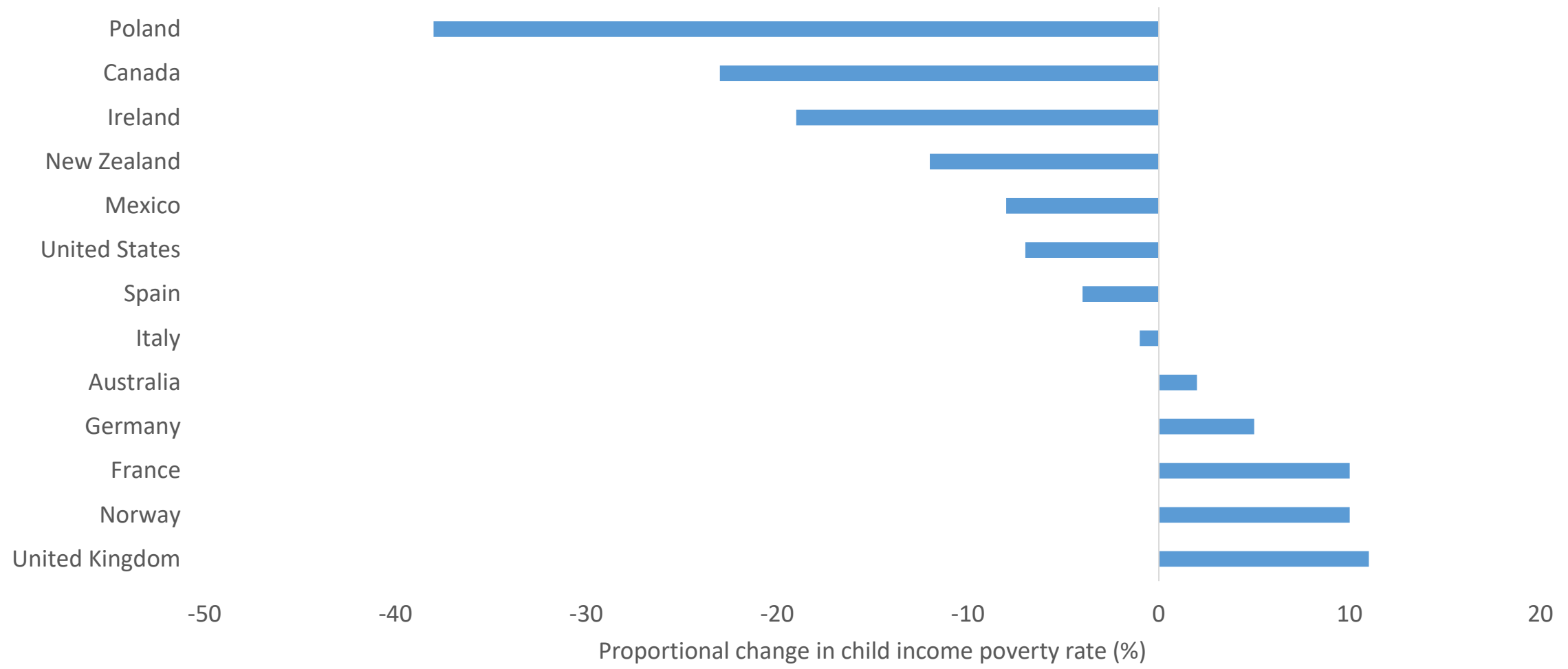
Do you think children today will have a better, worse or roughly the same life to you?

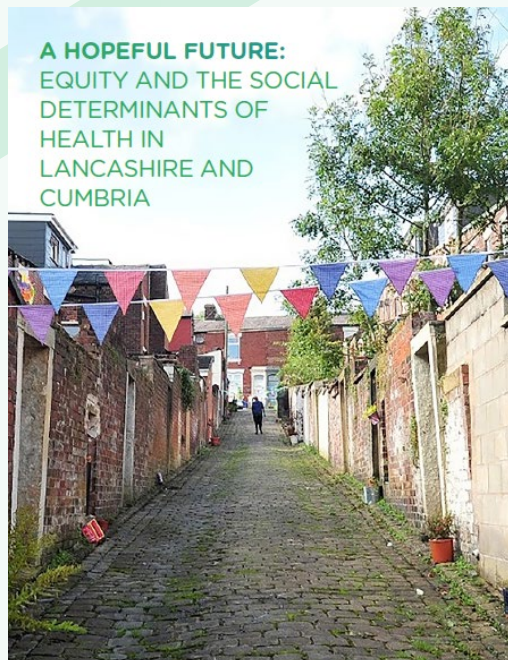
