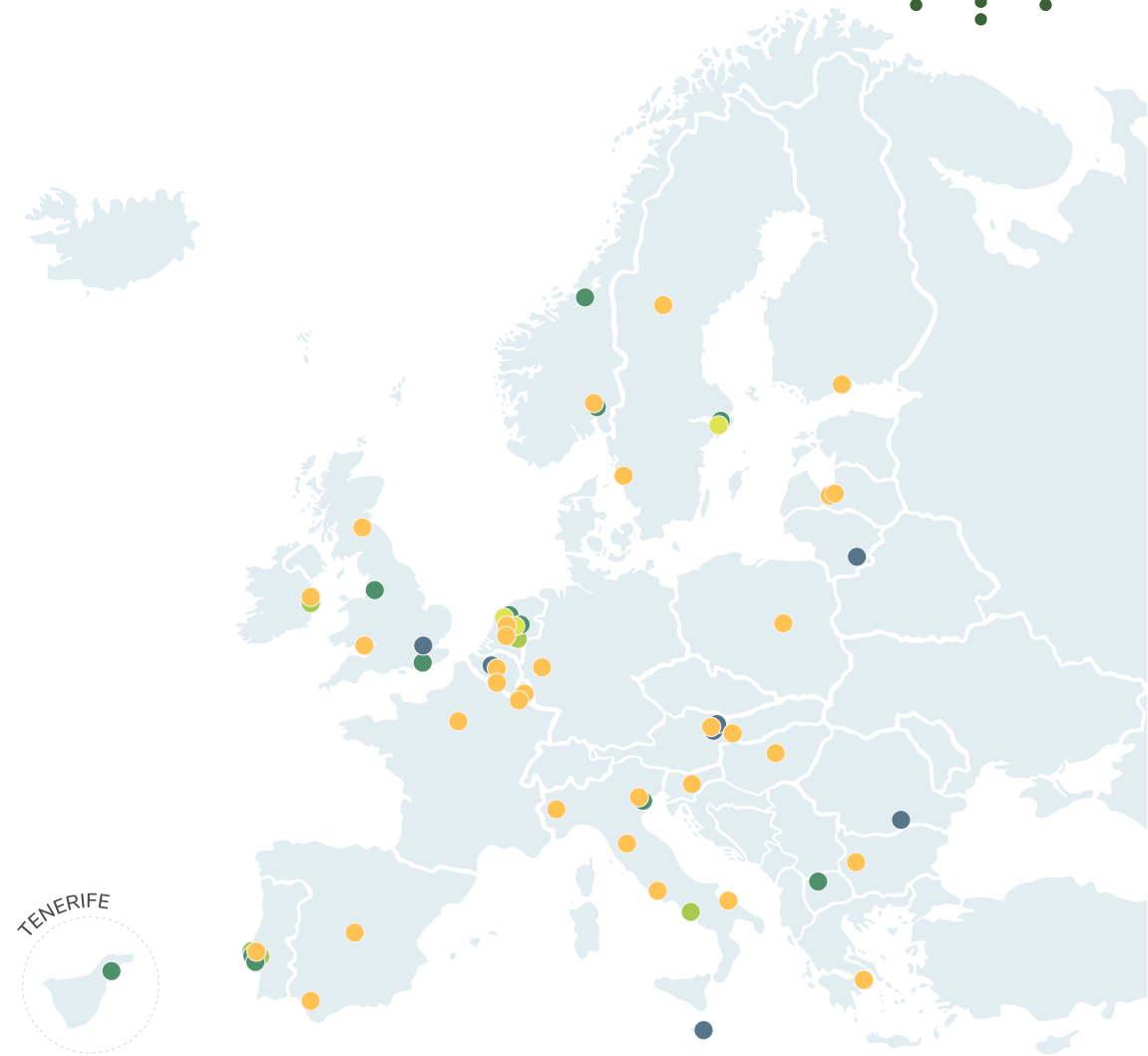

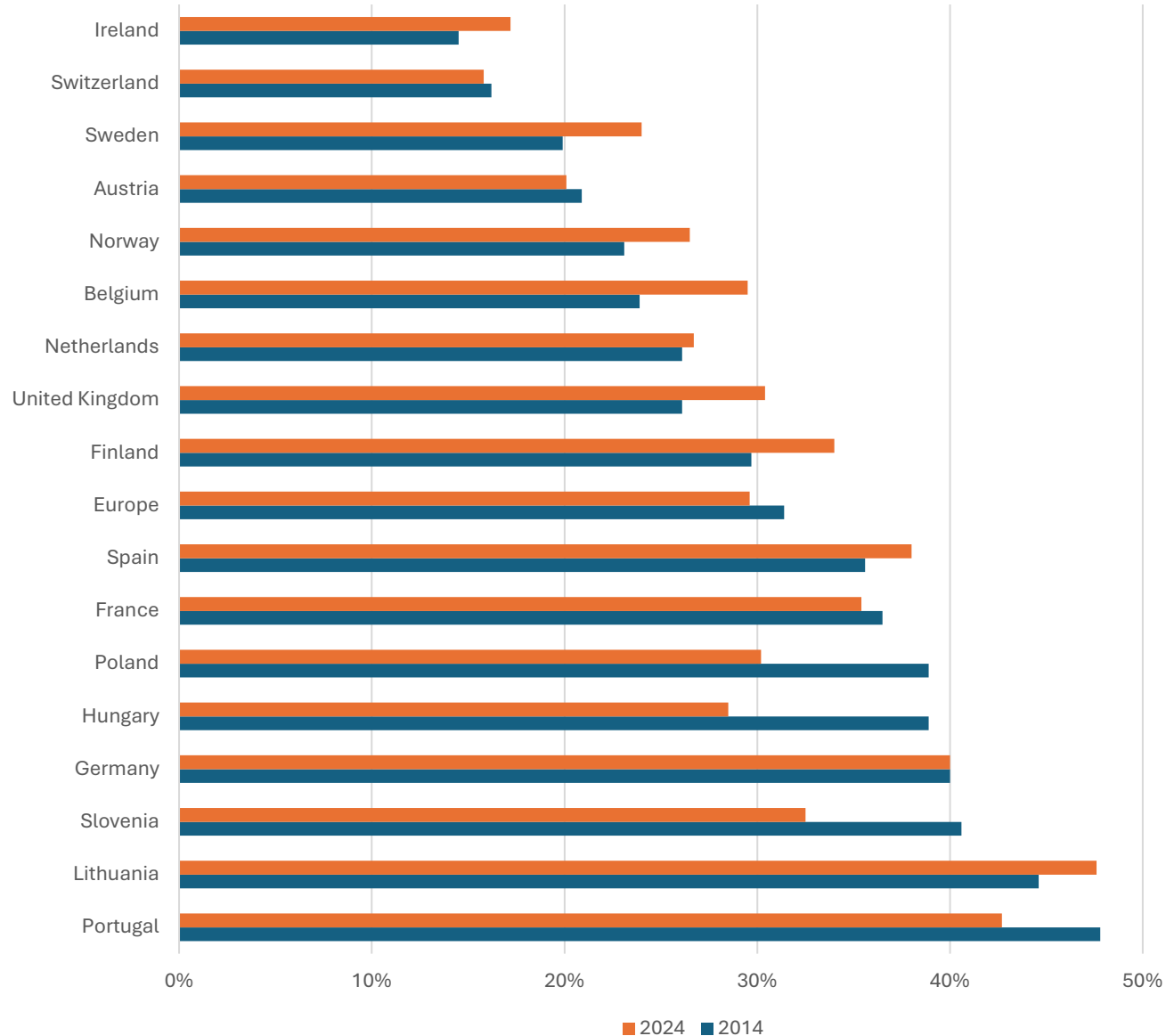

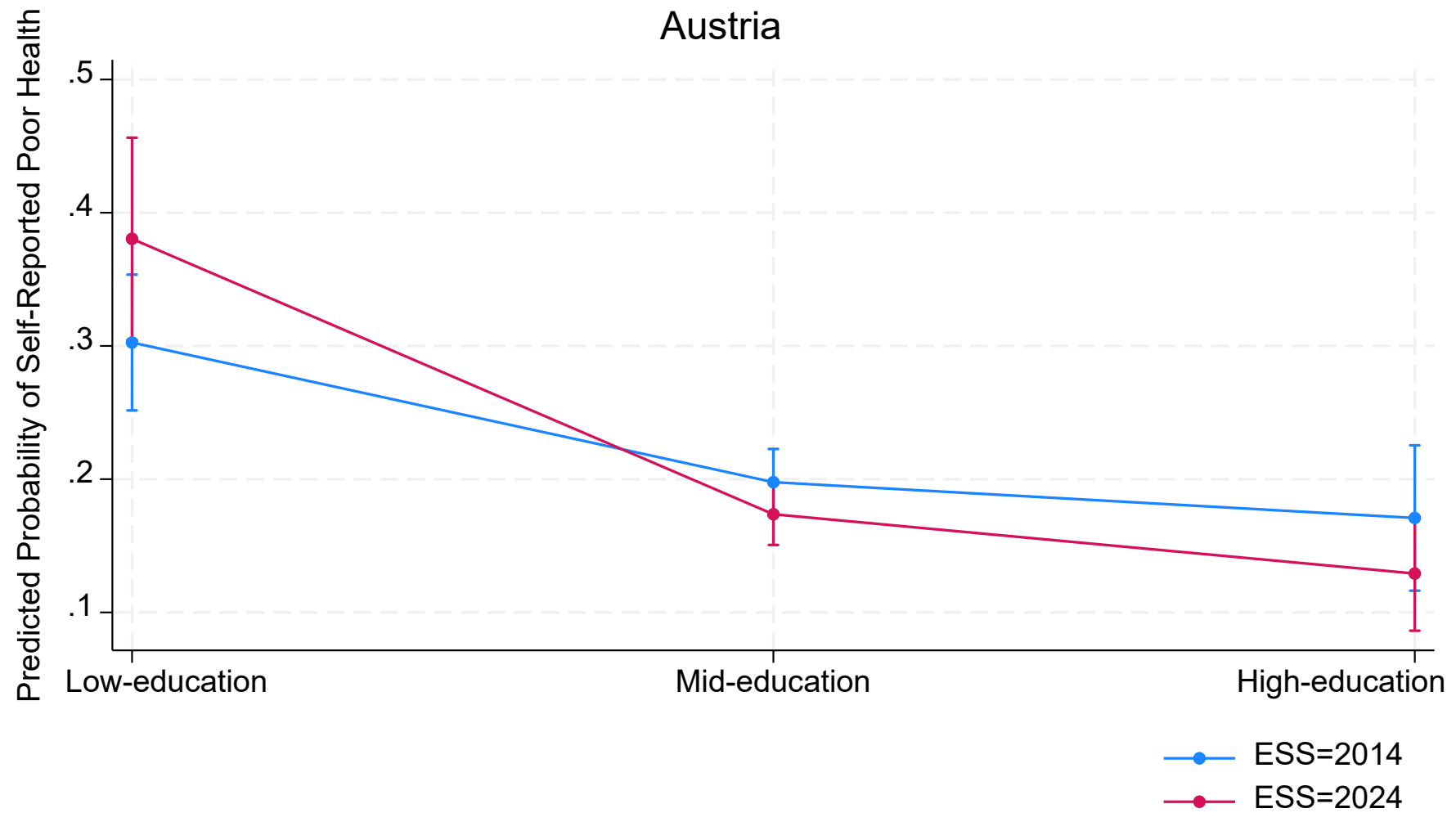


Rate of poor self-reported **health** 25-75-year-olds



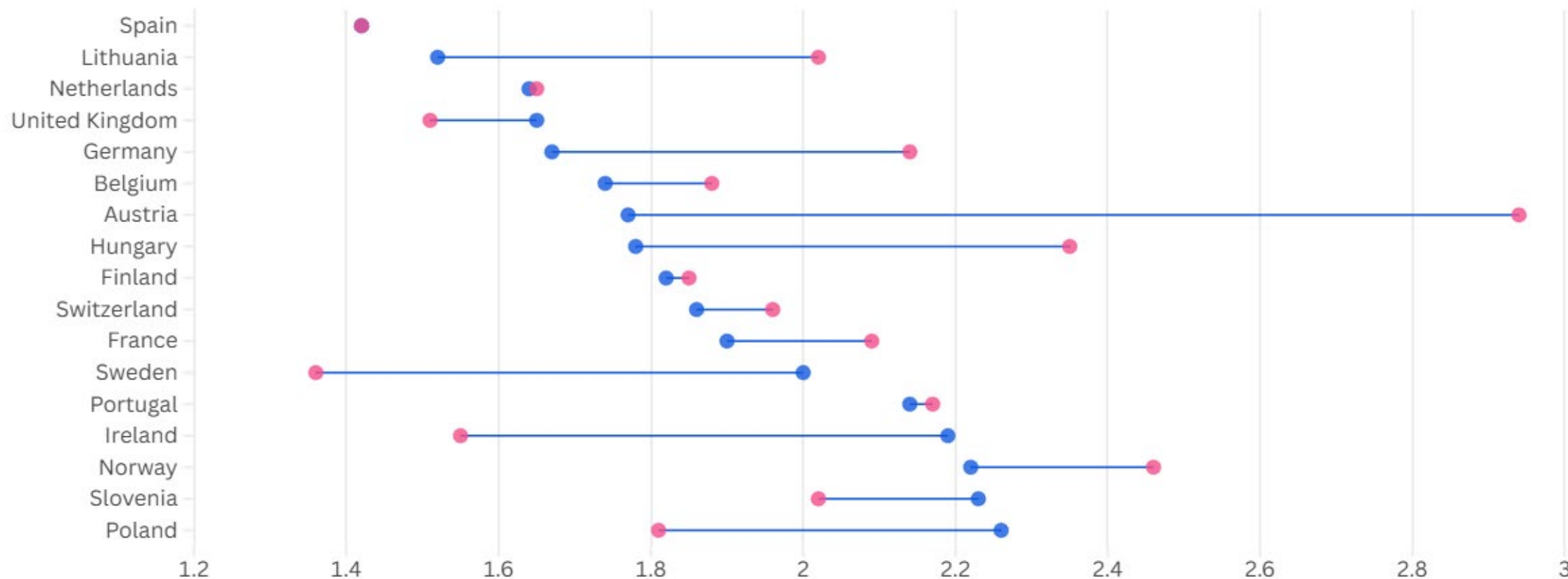
In 8/17 countries self-reported poor health increased

*Austria slight decrease
2014: 21%
2024: 20%*



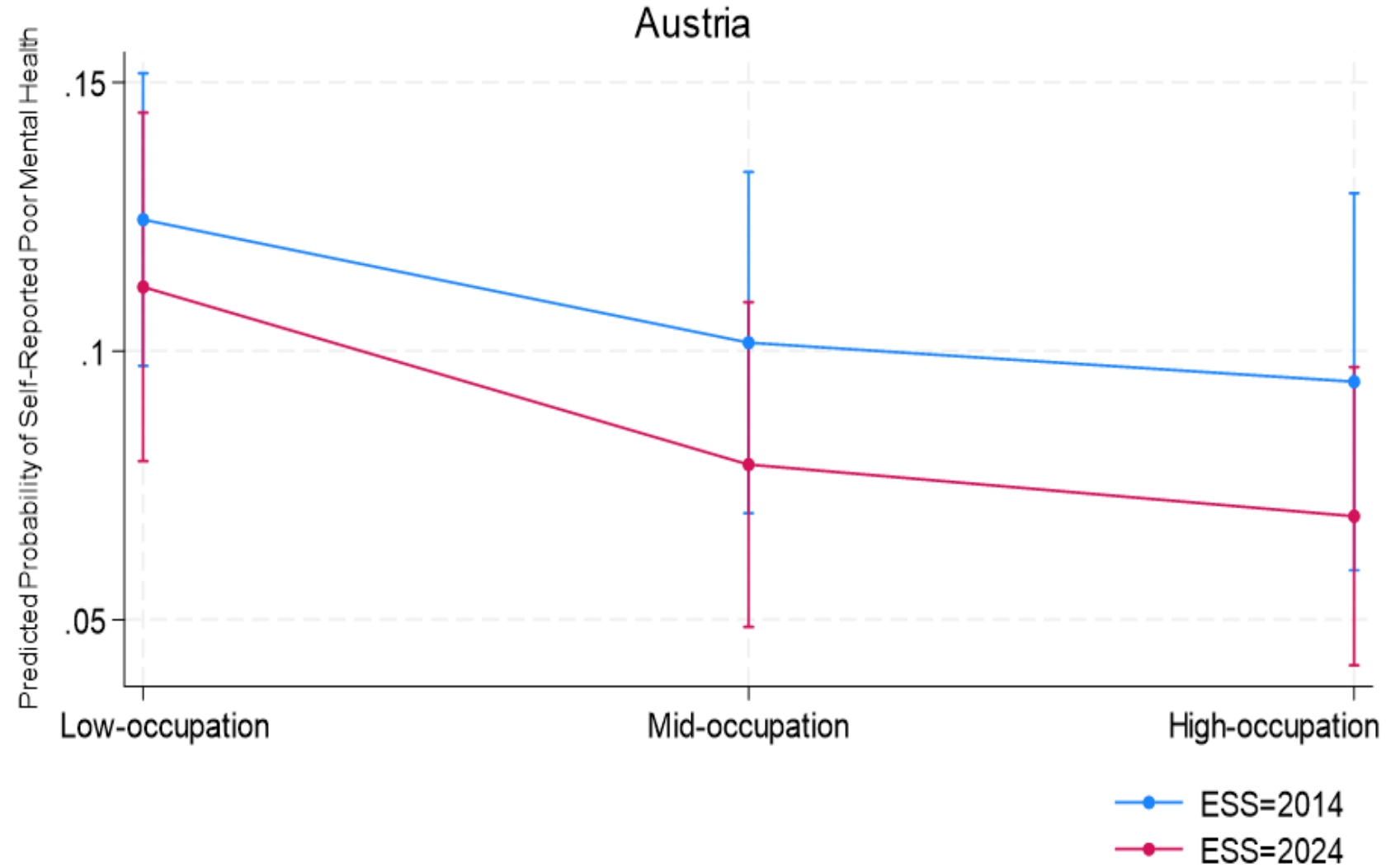
Changes in relative risk of education inequalities in poor self-reported health

Year ● 2014 ● 2024



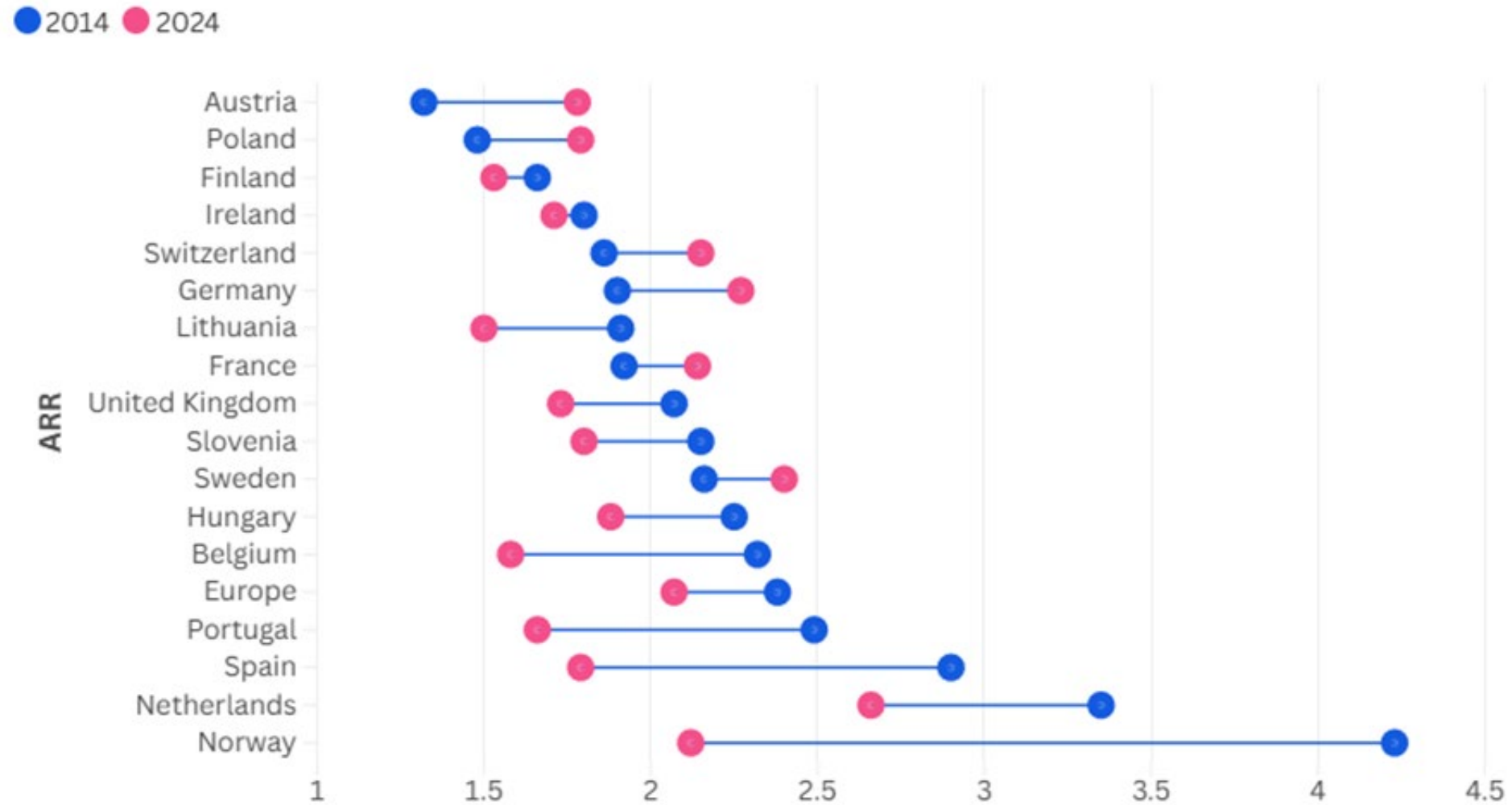
Rate of self-reported poor **mental health** 25-75-year-olds

Key take-aways for Austria

Overall levels of self-reported poor health are stable

1

BUT highest increase of inequalities in poor health among all surveyed countries

Self-reported poor mental health slightly improved for everyone BUT even more for higher occupational group
