






Rate of poor self-reported health 25-75-year-olds







Changes in relative risk of education inequalities in poor self-reported health



Rate of self-reported poor mental health 25-75-year-olds








Changes in relative risk of occupational inequalities in self-reported mental health







Key take-aways for Austria

Overall levels of selfreported poor health are stable BUT highest increase of inequalities in poor health among all surveyed countries

Self-reported poor mental health slightly improved for everyone BUT even more for higher occupational group
