

Rate of poor self-reported health, 25–75-year-olds, 2014-2024


Norway significant increase in poor health:

2014: 23%


2024: 27%








#### Changes in relative risk of education inequalities in health



Rate of poor self-reported mental health, 25–75-year-olds, 2014-2024








#### Mental health shifts within occupation groups







# Changes in relative risk of occupational inequalities in mental health

## Key take-aways for Norway

Overall levels of selfreported poor health are increasing Educational inequalities in poor health are increasing

Self-reported poor mental health is stable BUT high-occupation group show increasing trend of poor mental health


